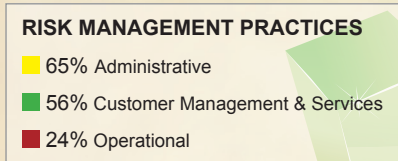
What is the RMES-C?

The Risk Management Evaluation System (RMES-C) is a quick, effective method which business owners and managers can use to evaluate how well their companies are protected from the major risk factors that affect their profitability and in some cases even their survival.

- ✓ **Asks 37 questions that require only a “Yes” or “No” answer**
- ✓ **Provides guidance on practical, often inexpensive, solutions to reduce risks**
- ✓ **Includes instructions and guidance written in layman’s terms**

RMES-C Contractors’ Benefits

Protect Your Business

All construction companies face a variety of risks as a part of doing business. **The RMES-C is the most comprehensive tool available to identify those risks and determine how to reduce them.**

- **Assure Risks Are Handled**
The RMES-C identifies the vast majority of risks faced by construction companies. Participating contractors know where they stand on the key administrative, operational and customer services practices that make a difference.
- **See How You Score**
The scoring feature in the RMES-C program enables contractors to see how they stand in terms of measured positive practices.
- **Demonstrate Control To Service Providers**
Using the RMES-C shows other service providers that the contractor knows and controls key factors affecting his/her business.
- **Qualify For Insurance Discounts**
